PASTOR'S MESSAGE

A year later....

- Yet worshipping together meeting in person and sharing communion.
- Bob Hansen has worked to provide worship services online and many are still participating online.
- We're singing (through our masks) to Lily and Jennifer's beautiful playing and Sylvia's singing to lead us.

- We're reaching out to those who are homebound and brining the sacrament to them too.
- We concluded interviews and called a pastor (and when he arrived invited him to contribute to this newsletter).
- We celebrated the installation for a pastor (November 14) and welcomed him and his spouse Sharon for their first Sunday on October 3.
- We celebrated Thanksgiving, Reformation, All Saints, and Christ the King.

What next?

- A transition team of folk from First and St. Matthew's meets to help the pastor get acquainted and at the same time to talk about what shared ministry might look like for us.
- We look forward to things we've "always" done on special days and holidays.
- We consider how to be the church knowing full well there are fewer of us and we're aging.
- We remain hopeful that God has lots for us to do together.
- We remain open to the Spirit's leading as we grow in loving God and our neighbour.
- We remain hopeful that even though we don't always know what's coming we have God and we have each other

The Christmas greetings Sharon and I send out to family and friends this year will include lots of news about a big move from one province to another as we've joined a new synod and new churches and are settling into a parsonage in Welland. We're still learning names and settling in. There are many days as I think back, I smile and comment, "that was joyous and that was fun." There are days I sigh and say, "that was tough" and offer prayers for those who need them. We are grateful for you and for God bringing us

together. As the days shorten and Christmas approaches many of us will be looking back to all the ways that God's promise to be with us has been fulfilled. Grace and peace to you this Advent and Christmas Season.

ADVENT AND CHRISTMAS WORSHIP AT ST. MATTHEW'S

The Advent Season is a time of anticipation and excitement as we watch and wait for Christmas. This year the first Sunday of Advent falls on November 28, 2021. Throughout the four Sundays in Advent, we will light the Advent candles during the 11:00 a.m. worship service as we prepare to welcome the Christ-child. Recently St. Matthew's council decided that all people attending inperson worship at St. Matthew's must show proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 (exceptions for children under 12, and people with a medical exemption.)

This requirement allows us to remove capacity limits and include congregational singing in worship! There is plenty of room for everyone to worship with us on Christmas Eve, Friday, December 24 at 6:30 p.m.

These changes are not a full return to normal! Masks must still be worn by everyone, communion will continue to consist of bread only, and non-contact gestures will remain in place.
